

**New York Theatre Ballet's Dance On A Shoestring – 31<sup>st</sup> Anniversary Season  
Repertory Highlights**

**New York** – The second performance of New York Theatre Ballet's Dance On A Shoestring series will take place on Friday and Saturday, February 5 & 6 at 7 pm at The Dance Gallery, 30 East 31<sup>st</sup> Street, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, NYC. Hailed as “**a miniature American treasure**” by Dance Magazine, NYTB will highlight excerpts from the company's repertory. Choreography by **Andrea Miller, Rachael Kosch** and **Marco Pelle** will be featured. Back by popular demand is an excerpt from “Blush” by Andrea Miller, co-director of Gallim Dance. “Blush” had its premiere at Jacob's Pillow this past summer.

**Three Virgins and A Devil**, set to music by Ottorino Respighi was choreographed by **Agnes de Mille**, and had its first performance in 1941. Based on a story of Boccaccio the ballet is the comic tale of three young virgins on their way to join a nunnery when they are confronted by a devil who uses each of their weakness to entice them into Hell, the mouth of which is a cave. The music will be performed live by NYTB music director **Mariko Miyazaki**.

The intimate Dance Gallery offers a unique performance experience where the audience not only sees the dance, but can observe behind-the-scenes elements of an informal theatrical experience. **Children from Ballet School NY** will also be featured on the program.
