In the Children's Division, qualified teaching assistants guarantee highly individualized instruction.

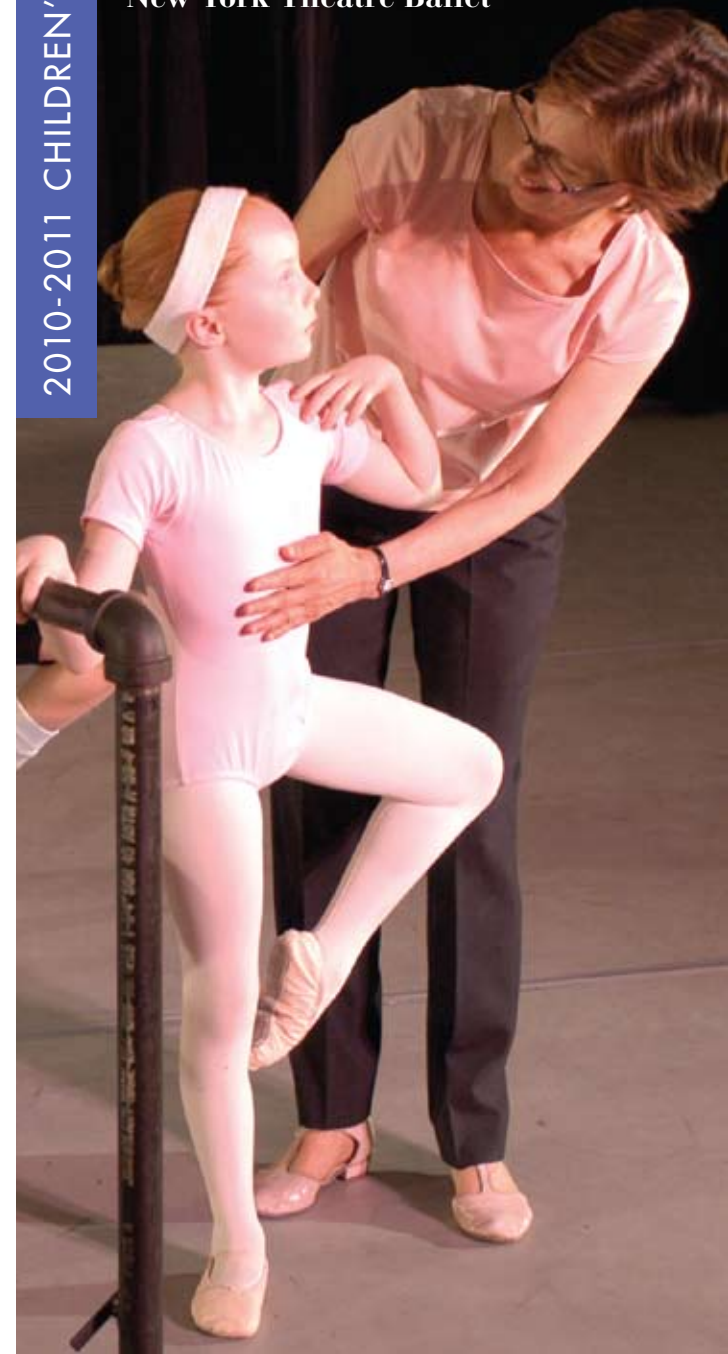

Classes begin Monday, September 20, 2010 and continue through the week ending June 10, 2011. The school is closed for major holidays.

To enter Pre-Ballet, children must be 4 years old before September 20, 2010. New students are admitted throughout the year as long as there is space in the class for which they qualify.

Workshops are 6 week sessions for Ballet II (by invitation) and all Ballet III students. Classes will include courses in modern dance, repertory and theater dance.

ENROLLMENT

Students under 18 years of age must be enrolled by a parent or legal guardian liable for tuition. The enrollment form should be completed by the responsible adult for each child enrolled and returned to Ballet School NY on or before the date of the first class together with the appropriate tuition payment. **Children will not be admitted into class without a completed enrollment form and required payment.**

BOYS

White leotard, black shorts, white socks, white ballet slippers. Boys in Ballet III are to wear a white leotard, black tights with a belt, white socks, and white ballet slippers.

Please note: All leotards must be plain. No attached skirts, rhinestones, puffy sleeves, fancy straps, or velvet. No split sole ballet slippers – full sole only. All girls are to wear pink tights and pink ballet slippers secured with one elastic. Long hair is to be worn in a bun (pony tails are not permitted in any class). Short hair must be covered with a hair net. All girls are to wear white head bands. All Pre-Ballet children should have their first name printed on the front of their leotard in bold, black letters. No embellishments.

CHILDREN WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN CLASS IF MORE THAN 5 MINUTES LATE.

The School reserves the right to suspend or dismiss any student if progress is unsatisfactory, attitude or deportment conflicts with the standards of the school, or actions are deemed detrimental to other students or to the School as a whole. An excessive number of absences may also result in dismissal.
