Ballet III students are required to take all scheduled classes.

Sat 11:15 – 12:45pm (technique)  
12:45 – 1:45pm (pointe)

Classes begin Monday, September 19, 2011 and continue through the week ending June 8, 2012. The school is closed for major holidays.

To enter Pre-Ballet, children must be 4 years old before September 19, 2011. New students are admitted throughout the year as long as there is space in the class for which they qualify.

## ENROLLMENT

Students under 18 years of age must be enrolled by a parent or legal guardian liable for tuition. The enrollment form should be completed by the responsible adult for each child enrolled and returned to Ballet School NY on or before the date of the first class, together with the appropriate tuition payment. **Children will not be admitted into class without a completed enrollment form and required payment.**

Tuition payments can be made by Mastercard, Visa, check or cash. Late payments are automatically subjected to a 5% late fee at the time of each billing. Students may not remain enrolled in any quarter for which payment for the previous quarter is still outstanding.

## CLASS ATTIRE

All leotard styles are Capezio unless otherwise noted. Children will not be permitted into class with other style and color leotards. Please order at least three weeks in advance.

## GIRLS' LEOTARD STYLES

Pre-Ballet I & II: pink, #CC400C

Pre-Ballet III: lavender, #CC400C

Ballet I: burgundy, #CC101C (child), #CC101 (adult)

Ballet II: royal blue, #CC101C (child), #CC101 (adult)

Ballet III: navy blue, #CC101C (child), #CC101 (adult)

All girls are required to wear pink tights and full sole pink ballet slippers, no split sole slippers. Each slipper should be secured by an elastic strap. Long hair is to be worn in a small bun. Pony tails are not permitted in any class. Short hair must be covered with a hair net. All girls in Pre-Ballet classes are to wear white head bands and have their first name printed on the front of their leotard in bold, black letters. Girls in Ballet I, II & III classes are to wear pink alignment belts Bodywrappers #BT1. No embellishments.

## BOYS

Pre-Ballet, Ballet I & II: white leotard, Baltogs #OSL132C, black shorts, Baltogs #315

Ballet III: white leotard, Baltogs #OSL132C, heather grey tights, Baltogs #1308F

All boys are to wear white socks and white, full sole ballet slippers.

CHILDREN WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN CLASS IF MORE THAN 5 MINUTES LATE.
